The dedications-ads can be submitted on a CD (photos as jpeg files and text using any text program.) Please include a printed copy of the ad so the final copy of the ad meets your expectations. Another way to submit your ad, if you can spend an hour, is to place all your photos (as jpeg) on a "flash stick" and build your ad with Mr. Robinson. He will take you to the yearbook page and you will see exactly how the ad will appear in the yearbook. ALL dedication-ads and payment need to be submitted to the school office by February 24, 2012.
